Bradley Manning is a young American military intelligence analyst whose mother is Welsh and grandfather Irish. He has been detained by the US for over a year, for most of that time under conditions of torture, on suspicion of leaking the Iraq 'Collateral Murder' footage to WikiLeaks, as well as the Iraq War Logs, Afghan War Diary and hundreds of thousands of US diplomatic cables.

'Collateral Murder' shows a US Apache helicopter attack on a group of pedestrians in 2007 which killed about a dozen people including two Reuters journalists. Two children were seriously injured when the helicopter fired on a van which came to the aid of the victims. The US covered up what happened in this incident and had refused to release the footage, but the truth is now there for everyone to see: www.collateralmurder.com

Bradley Manning is no longer in solitary confinement, but if he is convicted of the charges against him, he could face life imprisonment or even the Death Penalty.

MICHAEL LYONS

Michael Lyons is a young British Royal Navy medic who applied for discharge on the grounds of conscientious objection soon after being told that he would be deployed to Afghanistan in 2010. He asked to be assigned to a non-combat role in the meantime, which was refused, as was his request not to take part in any combat activities. Lyons declined to follow an order to take part in rifle training, for which he was court martialled. His application for conscientious objection was rejected, even though his Commanding Officer had supported it.

During the court martial hearing in July, Lyons said that the WikiLeaks revelations about Iraq and Afghanistan had influenced his decision. He said 'My initial objections started with Afghanistan and I wanted to investigate the reasons why we were at war. At the time, WikiLeaks came along and mentioned Iraq and Afghanistan. The reports said there had been some civilian casualties that nobody knew about and they were being covered up.'

In spite of his moral and ethical objections to war, the court martial found Michael Lyons guilty of disobeying a lawful order and sentenced him to 7 months detention.
