**Watch the film. Join in the discussion.**

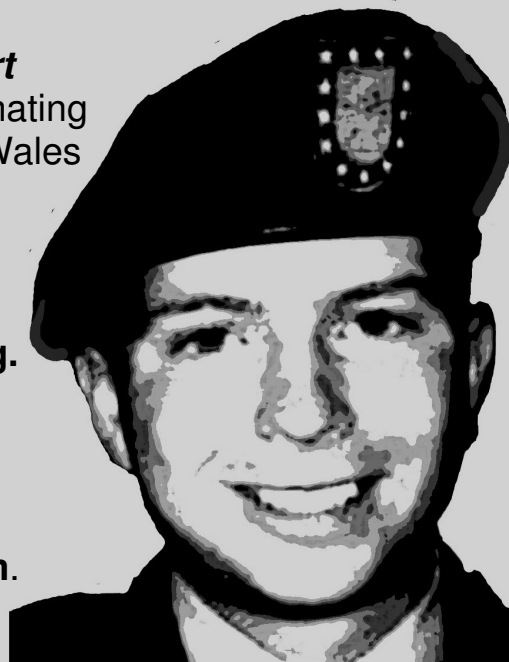
The meeting will be opened by **Côr Cochion Caerdydd**.
