In August, army intel. analyst Private Manning was sentenced to 35 years in U.S. military prison (Fort Leavenworth, Kansas) on 20 counts of 'espionage' for blowing the whistle on war crimes in Iraq and Afghanistan and revealing the truth about U.S. intervention and interference around the world.

American-born Manning has Welsh and Irish roots and ten years ago was a teenager attending school in Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire. Manning was aged 22 when arrested, was held for over 3 years without trial and subjected to inhuman and degrading treatment condemned by the U.N. Special Rapporteur on Torture, Amnesty and many others. Manning has been nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize each of the past three years.

As the Rugby League World Cup gets underway, with U.S.A., Wales and Ireland all represented, join us to 'pack a scrum of solidarity' with Manning and family.
